

OBSEQUIOUSNESS

Meaning: Obsequiousness is the quality of being excessively eager to please or flatter others, often to the point of being insincere or servile.

1. His obsequiousness towards his boss was evident in the way he constantly flattered her decisions.
2. The obsequiousness of the staff made the customers feel uncomfortable, as it seemed overly insincere.
3. She could not tolerate the obsequiousness of her colleague, who would go to great lengths to win favor.
4. The politician's obsequiousness towards wealthy donors raised concerns about his integrity and priorities.
5. Despite his intelligence, his obsequiousness left others questioning his ability to lead with authority.
