

OBSTINATION

Meaning: Obstination refers to a stubbornness or persistence in holding onto a particular belief or course of action, often despite contrary evidence or opposition.

1. His obstination in pursuing the project despite overwhelming evidence against it was both admirable and frustrating.
2. The child's obstination about not eating vegetables led to a long-lasting battle at the dinner table.
3. Despite the team's efforts to mediate, her obstination made it impossible to reach a compromise.
4. His obstination to change his mind, even in the face of compelling arguments, became a point of contention among his peers.
5. The obstination displayed by the committee in rejecting any alternative proposals hindered progress on the project.
