Meaning: Obtruncate means to shorten or cut off part of something to highlight or emphasize a particular aspect.

1. The artist decided to obtruncate the painting to emphasize the central figure.
2. In an effort to obtruncate the lengthy presentation, she focused on the key points.
3. The editor chose to obtruncate the article, removing unnecessary details for clarity.
4. To fit the time constraints, they had to obtruncate the script before the performance.
5. His tendency to obtruncate complex ideas often led to misunderstandings in discussions.
