Meaning: To obtund means to dull or lessen the intensity of something, such as emotions or mental clarity.

1. The constant noise from the construction site seemed to obtund her ability to concentrate.
2. His extensive explanations often served to obtund the excitement of the audience instead of enhancing it.
3. In an attempt to obtund his pain, he resorted to meditation and deep breathing exercises.
4. The medication was prescribed to obtund the symptoms of his anxiety during stressful situations.
5. She hoped the calm environment would obtund her overwhelming feelings of stress.
