Meaning: OBTUSE: lacking sharpness or quickness of intellect; dull or insensitive in understanding, or relating to an angle greater than 90 degrees but less than 180 degrees.

2. The painter chose an obtuse angle to give the landscape an unusual perspective that intrigued viewers.
3. Despite his intelligence, he often took an obtuse approach to problem-solving, missing the obvious solutions.

5. The geometry teacher explained that an obtuse triangle has one angle measuring more than 90 degrees.
