

OBUMBRANT

Meaning: Obumbrant: casting a shadow or providing shade; overshadowing.

1. The towering cliffs obumbrant the valley below, casting long shadows as the sun began to set.
2. In the painting, the artist used darker shades to obumbrant the figures, giving them a more dramatic presence.
3. A dense canopy of trees obumbrant the forest floor, creating a cool refuge from the summer heat.
