Meaning: Obversion is the logical process of transforming a proposition into its negative counterpart by changing its quality and negating its predicate.

1. Obversion is often used in logic to transform a proposition into its negative counterpart.

3. The obversion of "All swans are white" would be "No swans are non-white."
