Meaning: Ochlocracy is a form of government in which the mob or masses exert control, often leading to disorder and undermining established democratic systems.

1. Ochlocracy often arises in times of social unrest when the general populace seeks to assert its power.
2. The philosopher warned that ochlocracy could lead to mob rule, undermining democratic institutions.
3. In a state of ochlocracy, decisions may be driven more by popular emotion than by rational debate.
4. Historically, instances of ochlocracy have demonstrated the fragility of civil order in the face of mass movements.
5. Political theorists debate whether ochlocracy is a temporary phase or a more permanent shift in governance.

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
