2. Her offhand attitude during the meeting suggested that she wasn't taking the project seriously.
3. I didn't mean to offend you with my offhand comment; it was just a casual observation.
4. Although his suggestion seemed offhand, it actually sparked a valuable discussion.
5. She often makes offhand jokes that lighten the mood at work.
