Meaning: Onomatope: a word that phonetically imitates, resembles, or suggests the sound it describes.

1. The word 'buzz' is a classic example of an onomatope that mimics the sound of bees.
2. Children often delight in creating their own onomatope as they play pretend.
3. In poetry, the use of onomatope can bring text to life by evoking vivid auditory imagery.
4. The term onomatope refers to words that phonetically imitate the sounds they describe.
