

# OPERCULIFORM

*Meaning: Operculiform: having a lid-like or cover-like shape or structure, as seen in certain designs or biological features that facilitate protection or access.*

1. The operculiform design of the container made it easy to access the contents without any spills.
2. In biology, certain species of snails exhibit an operculiform structure that protects their soft bodies when retracted into their shells.
3. The artist used an operculiform motif in the sculpture to symbolize protection and enclosure.
4. During the dissection, the operculiform valves were carefully examined for their role in the organism's respiratory system.
5. The operculiform shape of the lid provided an innovative solution to prevent contamination in laboratory samples.
