Meaning: Oppilative refers to a characteristic of being obstructive or blocking, particularly in discussions or arguments, thereby limiting the possibility of alternative viewpoints or resolutions.

1. The oppilative nature of the argument left little room for counterpoints.
2. In the debate, his oppilative stance seemed to overshadow any potential compromise.
3. Her oppilative reasoning effectively closed off any alternative perspectives.
4. The oppilative approach taken by the committee hindered open dialogue among members.
5. His oppilative remarks during the meeting created an atmosphere of tension and defensiveness.
