Meaning: Orbit: the curved path that an object takes around a planet, star, or moon due to gravitational forces.

1. The satellite will enter a stable orbit around the planet next week.
2. Astronomers use telescopes to observe the orbit of distant celestial bodies.
3. The moon's orbit around Earth takes approximately 27.3 days to complete.
4. As the spacecraft adjusted its orbit, the crew prepared for re-entry procedures.
5. Understanding the gravitational forces at play is essential for calculating an object's orbit.
