

ORCHOTOMY

Meaning: Orchotomy is a surgical procedure involving the incision or removal of one or both testicles.

1. The surgeon explained that an orchotomy might be necessary to address the patient's testicular issue.
2. After the orchotomy, the recovery process involved careful monitoring for any signs of infection.
3. An orchotomy is often performed in cases of testicular torsion or cancer.
