Meaning: ORDONNANCE: A formal order or prescription issued by a medical professional or a legal authority.

1. The doctor issued an ordonnance to ensure the patient received their medication on time.
2. After reviewing the case, the judge handed down an ordonnance that outlined the terms of the settlement.
3. The city council approved the new zoning ordonnance to facilitate urban development.
4. In France, an ordonnance can refer to a prescription written by a healthcare professional.
5. The government's ordonnance aimed to regulate the use of public spaces during the pandemic.
