Meaning: To move or swing back and forth in a rhythmic manner or to fluctuate between different states or opinions.

1. The pendulum began to oscillate back and forth with increasing speed.
2. During the debate, the opinions of the panelists seemed to oscillate between support and opposition.
3. As the music played, the dancers began to oscillate in rhythm with the beat.
4. The temperature can oscillate significantly between day and night in the desert.
5. The stock market tends to oscillate wildly based on investor sentiment and news reports.
