Meaning: Ostensibly means appearing to be true or outwardly stated, but possibly not reflecting the actual situation or intent.

1. She ostensibly left the party early to prepare for her presentation.
2. The new policy was ostensibly designed to improve employee morale.
3. He was ostensibly studying, but I suspected he was actually watching TV.
4. Ostensibly, the meeting was about budget cuts, but it turned into a discussion about future projects.
5. She smiled at him, ostensibly friendly, but her eyes told a different story.
