Meaning: OUTSTARE: To maintain a prolonged gaze at someone or something, often in a challenging or confrontational manner, without blinking or looking away.

1. She tried to outstare her opponent, determined not to blink first.
2. The intense gaze of the lion made it clear he could outstare anyone who dared approach.
3. In the silent room, they began a game to see who could outstare the other without flinching.
4. With a fierce determination, he attempted to outstare the reflection in the mirror, seeking confidence.
5. The children giggled as they attempted to outstare each other during their playful competition.
