Meaning: OUTSTRETCH: to extend or reach outwards, often in a way that conveys eagerness or expansive coverage.

1. The artist's hand began to outstretch towards the canvas, eager to create.
2. As the sun began to set, its rays outstretched over the horizon, painting the sky in vibrant hues.
3. She decided to outstretch her arms in a warm welcome when she saw her friend.
4. The athlete's legs seemed to outstretch the distance as he leaped over the hurdles.
5. During the yoga session, the instructor encouraged everyone to outstretch their bodies for better flexibility.
