

OVATE-LANCEOLATE

Meaning: Ovate-lanceolate refers to a leaf or petal shape that is egg-shaped (ovate) and elongated with a pointed tip (lanceolate), tapering towards one end.

1. The leaves of the plant were ovate-lanceolate, tapering gracefully towards the tip.
2. In the botanical description, the flowers were noted for their ovate-lanceolate petals, adding elegance to the bloom.
3. During the field study, we observed that the ovate-lanceolate shape of the leaves played a role in water retention.
4. The artist captured the essence of the tree with its ovate-lanceolate foliage swaying gently in the breeze.
5. Identifying the species became easier once we recognized the distinct ovate-lanceolate leaf structure.
