

OVATO-ACUMINATE

Meaning: Ovato-acuminate refers to a leaf shape that is egg-shaped (ovate) with a pointed tip (acuminate).

1. The ovato-acuminate leaves of the plant create a striking visual contrast against the dark soil.
2. Botanists noted the ovato-acuminate shape of the foliage as a key identifier for this species.
3. During the field study, the researchers collected samples of the ovato-acuminate leaves to analyze their chlorophyll content.
4. The ovato-acuminate form of the leaves helps the plant reduce water loss in arid environments.
5. In her garden, she favored species with ovato-acuminate leaves for their elegant appearance and unique texture.
