Meaning: Overaction refers to an exaggerated or excessive response or performance, often resulting in a lack of authenticity or credibility.

1. The actor's overaction during the dramatic scene made it difficult for the audience to take him seriously.

3. Critics often argue that overaction in political debates detracts from the real issues at hand.
