Meaning: To overaffect means to excessively display or exaggerate emotions or traits, often resulting in a lack of authenticity or sincerity.

1. She tends to overaffect her emotions during important presentations, making her seem less genuine.
2. The actor's decision to overaffect his character's struggles detracted from the overall authenticity of the performance.
3. In an attempt to impress her friends, she often overaffects her excitement, which can be off-putting.
4. Critics argue that the director's choice to overaffect the film's climax diminished its emotional impact.
