

# OVERBEND

*Meaning: OVERBEND (verb): To bend something, such as wire or metal, excessively or beyond its intended limit, often resulting in distortion or weakening.*

1. The artist chose to overbend the wire to create a more dynamic sculpture.
2. If you overbend the metal during shaping, it could weaken the structure.
