

OVERBOIL

Meaning: To overboil means to heat a liquid to the point of boiling for too long, causing it to become excessively hot and potentially spill over or lose its desired texture.

1. Be careful not to overboil the pasta, or it will become mushy.
2. If you overboil the milk, it will create a mess on the stove.
3. The chef reminded the kitchen staff to watch the vegetables closely and avoid overboiling them.
4. She realized too late that she had overboiled the eggs, resulting in a rubbery texture.
5. To achieve the perfect tea, it's important not to overboil the water before adding the leaves.
