

# OVERCOLOR

*Meaning: Overcolor (verb): To apply excessive or overly intense colors to an artwork, often resulting in a loss of detail or balance.*

1. The artist decided to overcolor the landscape to create a more vibrant scene.
2. In her enthusiasm, she tended to overcolor each drawing, overshadowing the details.
3. The graphic designer warned that if you overcolor the logo, it might lose its professional appeal.
4. To avoid overwhelming the viewer, it's essential not to overcolor the elements in your presentation.
5. Critics noted that the film's visuals were stunning, but at times, they seemed to overcolor the story's emotional depth.
