

# OVERFLOAT

*Meaning: Overfloat (verb): to issue more shares of a company's stock than originally planned, often to raise additional capital, which may lead to dilution of existing shareholders' ownership.*

1. The company decided to overfloat its shares to raise additional capital for expansion.
2. Some investors were concerned that the decision to overfloat might dilute their existing ownership.
3. In an effort to enhance liquidity, the management team proposed to overfloat a portion of the stock.
4. After careful consideration, the board voted unanimously to overfloat the equity to attract new investors.
5. Market analysts warned that an overfloat could lead to increased volatility in the stock price.
