

OVERFLY

Meaning: To fly over a specific area or location, typically at a higher altitude.

1. The drone will overfly the designated area to capture aerial footage.
2. Birds often overfly the region during their seasonal migrations.
3. We watched as the aircraft began to overfly the city, providing stunning views.
4. The helicopter was forced to overfly the restricted zone due to the heavy traffic below.
5. As the storm approached, the weather radar indicated that the system would overfly us later in the evening.
