

OVERGLIDE

Meaning: Overglide refers to the act of exceeding a designated stopping point or trajectory, often resulting in loss of control during landing or descent.

1. The pilot had to correct the aircraft's trajectory to avoid an overglide situation during the landing approach.
2. As she skied down the slope, she lost control and began to overglide past the intended stopping point.
3. In the game of chess, a player may often overglide their strategy, leading to unexpected outcomes in the match.
4. The engineer noticed that the mechanism would overglide if the pressure was not calibrated correctly.
5. During the presentation, the speaker seemed to overglide through the slides, missing important details that needed emphasis.
