

OVERHANDLE

Meaning: Overhandle (verb): to handle something excessively or too roughly, often leading to damage or undesirable changes in its condition or quality.

1. The technician warned us not to overhandle the delicate equipment during the installation.
2. If you overhandle the dough, it can become tough and lose its desirable texture.
3. In an effort to impress, he tended to overhandle the negotiations, which led to confusion.
4. The artist prefers to let the paint flow naturally instead of overhandling the brushwork.
5. They cautioned the volunteers not to overhandle the fragile artifacts to preserve their integrity.
