Meaning: Overinfluence: to exert excessive or undue influence over someone or something, often resulting in a lack of diversity or autonomy in decision-making.

1. Her tendency to overinfluence the committee's decisions often stifled diverse opinions.
2. Parents sometimes overinfluence their children's career choices, leading to unfulfilled aspirations.
3. The marketing campaign aimed to overinfluence consumer behavior by appealing to their emotions.
4. In relationships, it's important to recognize when one partner may overinfluence the other's feelings and choices.
5. Experts warn that social media can overinfluence public perception of important issues.
