2. His overlying concern for her well-being often made him overprotective.
3. The overlying themes of the novel highlight the struggles of identity and belonging.
4. Their overlying ambitions clashed, leading to tension between the collaborators.
5. She found the overlying layer of paint made it difficult to see the original artwork beneath.
