

OVERPAINT

Meaning: OVERPAINT: To apply a new layer of paint over an existing one, often to enhance or alter the appearance of the original surface.

1. The artist decided to overpaint the original work to give it a fresh perspective.
2. To cover the unsightly marks on the wall, she chose to overpaint the entire surface.
3. The mural was so vibrant that it seemed a shame to overpaint it with dull colors.
4. After years of fading, the homeowners opted to overpaint the old siding to restore its appearance.
5. In an attempt to modernize the vintage piece, he began to overpaint sections that no longer appealed to him.
