

# OVERPART

*Meaning: Overpart (verb): To assign more roles or parts to actors than necessary, often to allow more individuals to participate or showcase their abilities.*

1. The director decided to overpart the roles in the play to ensure everyone had a chance to showcase their talents.
2. In the recent production, the actors felt that they were overparted, which led to confusion during rehearsals.
3. Critics noted that the tendency to overpart characters detracted from the overall cohesion of the film.
