

# OVERPRESS

*Meaning: Overpress (verb): to apply excessive pressure to a system or component, potentially leading to malfunction or failure.*

1. The engineer warned that overpressing the system could lead to catastrophic failure.
2. To avoid accidents, it is crucial not to overpress the hydraulic controls during operation.
3. The manufacturer's guidelines clearly state the maximum pressure limits to prevent overpress situations.

5. In the lab, they monitored the reaction closely to ensure they didn't overpress the gas chamber.
