Meaning: Override: to use authority or power to change or disregard a decision, rule, or setting.

1. The manager decided to override the system's default settings to better suit the team's needs.
2. In a surprising move, the board voted to override the CEO's decision regarding the budget cuts.
3. Some software allows users to override security features for specific tasks, but this can pose risks.
4. When the emergency alarm sounded, the captain had to override all previous instructions to ensure safety.
5. Legislation can often override local laws, leading to confusion among residents about compliance.
