

OVERRIGGED

Meaning: Overrigged: equipped with excessive rigging or lines, resulting in complications or difficulties in handling or navigation.

1. The sailboat was overrigged, making it difficult to navigate through the narrow channel.
2. After inspecting the mast, the crew realized they had overrigged the lines, leading to unnecessary strain.
3. The overrigged setup caused the vessel to list to one side during the storm.
4. He decided to simplify the rigging after noticing it was overrigged for the light winds.
5. In competitive sailing, being overrigged can hinder performance and slow down the boat.
