Meaning: To oversay means to express or state something excessively or more than necessary, often leading to misunderstanding or overwhelm.

1. It's easy to oversay something when you're trying to make a point.
2. In her excitement, she tended to oversay her feelings, often overwhelming her friends.
3. He didn't want to oversay his gratitude, but he genuinely appreciated the help.
4. When discussing her plans, she oversaid her ambitions, leaving some colleagues skeptical.
5. To avoid confusion, it's best not to oversay the details during the presentation.
