1. I decided to overskip the meeting since I had a prior engagement.
2. She tends to overskip important details when she rushes through her work.
3. To save time, he chose to overskip the introductory chapter of the book.
4. They overskip the usual pleasantries to get straight to the point of the discussion.
5. The teacher warned the students not to overskip any steps in the math problem.
