

OVERSLIDE

Meaning: Overslide (noun): the movement or sliding down of soil or materials, typically due to gravity or external forces, often triggered by factors like heavy rain or improper management.

1. The heavy rain caused a significant overslide of soil down the hillside.
2. During the construction, the team had to carefully monitor the site to prevent an overslide of materials.
3. After the earthquake, engineers assessed the risk of overslide in the affected areas.
4. The steep terrain made it more susceptible to an overslide, prompting the need for additional support structures.
