

OVERSLOP

Meaning: Overslop (verb): To apply or spread a substance, such as paint or adhesive, in excess or carelessly, resulting in a thick, uneven, or messy application.

1. The artist decided to overslop the paint to create a textured effect on the canvas.
2. During the renovation, they accidentally overslopped the adhesive, leading to a messy finish.
3. To prevent any spills, she was careful not to overslop the glue while assembling the model.
4. His tendency to overslop the details made the report overly complicated and hard to follow.
