Meaning: Overstate: to exaggerate or present something as more significant or important than it actually is.

1. It's easy to overstate the importance of a single moment in our lives.
2. The politician tended to overstate the achievements of his administration during the speech.
3. Critics argue that the media often overstates the impact of celebrity culture on youth.
4. In her enthusiasm, she might overstate the benefits of the new policy to gain support.
5. He didn't want to overstate his experience, but he had worked in the field for over a decade.
