

OVERSTRIKE

Meaning: Overstrike: to apply one layer or mark over another, often resulting in a combined or altered effect.

1. The artist used a unique technique to overstrike color layers in her painting, creating a vibrant effect.
2. When typing, it's easy to accidentally overstrike the keys and produce a jumble of letters.
3. In the final draft of the document, he decided to overstrike certain sections to indicate they were no longer relevant.
4. The composer chose to overstrike the original notes in the score to emphasize the new arrangement.
5. During the editing process, she had to overstrike several lines to make the argument clearer and more concise.
