Meaning: OVERTILT: To excessively lean or incline in a particular direction, either physically (as in gymnastics) or in terms of bias (as in arguments).

1. The gymnast tended to overtilt during her routine, which affected her balance.
2. In the debate, he seemed to overtilt toward emotional arguments instead of facts.
3. The architect warned that if they overtilt the design, it could compromise the building's stability.
4. She realized that she had a tendency to overtilt her opinions, making discussions more heated than necessary.
5. During the presentation, he overtilted the data visualization, causing confusion among the audience.
