1. The constant rain caused the hikers to overtread the muddy trails.
2. He overtread the boundaries of propriety during the heated debate.
3. In his eagerness to impress, he inadvertently overtread the established rules.
4. The gardener was careful not to overtread the delicate seedlings in the new bed.
5. She felt that he often overtread the limits of their friendship with his demands.
