

# OVERWASH

*Meaning: Overwash is the process by which water and sediment flow over the beach or dune system, often during storms, leading to changes in coastal landscapes and potential erosion.*

1. Overwash can significantly alter coastal landscapes during severe storms.
2. The engineers warned that excessive overwash might erode the protective dunes.
3. During the last hurricane, the beach experienced considerable overwash, flooding nearby roads.
4. Scientists study overwash patterns to better predict the impacts of climate change on shorelines.
5. After the storm, the overwash left a thick layer of sand on the coastal highway.
