

OVIPOSITOR

Meaning: Ovipositor: a specialized organ in female insects used for laying eggs, often adapted for specific reproductive functions.

1. The female wasp uses her ovipositor to lay eggs in the host plant.
2. During the study, researchers observed how the ovipositor of the dragonfly is adapted for precise egg placement.
3. The ovipositor of certain species can extend significantly to reach deeper into the substrate for egg deposition.
4. Entomologists often analyze the structure of the ovipositor to classify different insect species.
5. In some butterflies, the ovipositor is equipped with sensors to detect suitable laying sites.
