Meaning: A pacer is a person or device that sets and maintains a steady pace or rhythm for others to follow, often used in contexts like running or educational activities.

1. The pacer kept a steady rhythm during the marathon, helping runners maintain their pace.

3. The company launched a new fitness app that includes a virtual pacer to track running speed.
