

PALAMATE

Meaning: Palamate refers to a structure or arrangement that is webbed or lobed, resembling a paddle, as seen in certain bird feet for swimming or in the arrangement of leaves for optimizing light absorption.

1. The palamate structure of the bird's foot allows it to swim effectively in water.
2. In botany, the palamate arrangement of leaves can enhance light absorption for photosynthesis.
3. The artist used palamate shapes in her sculpture to evoke the natural forms found in aquatic life.
4. During the study, researchers observed that palamate adaptations in certain species improved their survival rates.
5. The design of the palamate claw in crustaceans is crucial for their ability to navigate through murky waters.
