Meaning: Palinodial: relating to a retraction or withdrawal of a previous statement or opinion, often expressing regret or a change of perspective.

1. His palinodial statement acknowledged past mistakes and sought forgiveness.
2. The artist's new work served as a palinodial reflection on her previous controversial pieces.
3. After years of promoting that ideology, the politician's palinodial speech surprised many of his supporters.
4. In a rare act of humility, the author published a palinodial essay addressing his earlier views.
5. The film ended with a palinodial message, urging audiences to reconsider their preconceived notions.
